Agenda:

Beginning Sunday, 24th May 2020 at 7:00 PM with opening ceremonies at the Marina Punat AASW Race tent. 10 races (at max.) are planned from Monday, May 25th until Thursday, May 28th 2020. Award ceremonies and official dinner are scheduled for Thursday, May 28th 2020 at 7:00 PM (all at the AASW Race tent).

Valuation classes:

- **"Alpe Adria Cup"**: Open class, mono-hull-yachts exceeding 7m (22.97 ft.), Spinnaker admitted
- **"Austria Cup"**: One-Design class (First 35), Spinnaker admitted; ÖSV crews and teams.
- **"Carinthian Cruising Trophy"**: open class, mono-hull-yachts exceeding 7m (22.97 ft), Spinnaker admitted, 50%+ of the crew (incl. skipper) resident in Carinthia.
- **"Alpe Adria Cruising Cup"**: open class, Mono-hull-yachts exceeding 7m (22.97 ft), Spinnaker not admitted.

Area:

Maritime area Kvarneric – point of departure: Marina Punat, Island of Krk

Races, routes:

For all classes 10 races in categories: "long race", "navigation race", "triangles" and "Up&Down" are foreseen. Four successful races and above -1 cancellation is applicable.

Race conduct: Ted Weidlich (HRS), Denis Marinov (HRS)

Regulations, evaluation:

World Sailing (WRS) current version ("Sailing instructions"). ORC measuring certificate 2020 is required except for One-Design Class.

Prizes:

The "Alpe Adria Cup", "Austria Cup", and the "Kärntner Cruising Trophy" are awarded as Challenge Trophies. There are prizes for all classes and groups for the grades one to three. There is a "Blue Ribbon" provided for the fastest yacht according to its sailing time.

Participation costs:

Nomination fee per yacht € 290

Nomination fee per person € 280s/person (different rebates possible)

Included in the nomination fee:

Preliminary activities and organisation. Technical equipment, registration, anchorage fees, complete racing administration, evaluation and printing of day and total results, OCEAN7-Newsletter, professional photos for the daily slideshow.
